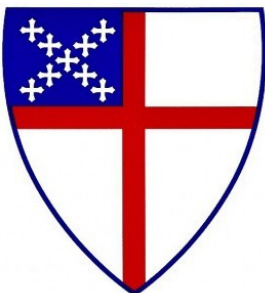

Joanna Morse of Americare Hospice in Franklin will join us June 11 to talk about Hospice care. She began dealing with end of life issues in the 90s at Greenwood Village South when she worked in spiritual care. She has also led many grief support groups. In 2009, Joanna served Americare Home Health and Hospice as a part time Chaplain and began full time in 2015 as their Spiritual/Bereavement/Volunteer Coordinator.

She will address the myths, fears, and questions about Hospice care. Joanna believes there are many parallels between the beginning and end of life. She says, “We have lots of resources for new parents as they welcome a new life into the world. Why not have similar resources for those dealing with issues at the end of a loved one’s life?”
